NOTE:

1. For Kho Kho Boys of U-14, the concerned Vidyalaya should provide refreshment @ Rs 100/- per day per child during coaching camp.
2. During coaching camp of Kho Kho Boys of U-17, the venue Vidyalaya will make necessary arrangement for boarding and lodging of the participants as per KVS Sports Modalities.
3. The escort teachers of KVS National for Kho Kho (U-14, 17 Boys) will report on 17th June 2019 (F/N) to the Principal of Coaching Camp Venue.

4. The coaching for Kho Kho Boys U-14, 17 will be given by the sports coaches appointed by the respective KVs for which payment should be given to the coaches. Those KV's not having coaches for the above mentioned games / sport can appoint qualified coaches and the remuneration may be paid out of VVN with the approval of VEC as per KVS rule.
5. The escorts along with the participants of Kho Kho Boys U-14, 17 of KVS National Meet 2019 will move directly to the railway station based on the train schedule. The Venue Principal will make all the necessary arrangement for transporting these students to the concerned Railway Station.
6. The Venue TGT (P&HE) / deputed TGT (P & HE) of Kho Kho Boys U-14, 17 will be on duty for coordinating the coaching camp and will make all necessary arrangement for local/friendly matches with nearby clubs.
7. The Venue principal of Kho Kho U-14, 17 Boys will make necessary arrangement for coordinating the coaching camp and will make all necessary arrangement for local/friendly matches with nearby clubs.
8. At least 3 to 4 friendly matches are to be played during the coaching camp before the team leaves for the 50th KVS National Sports meet 2019.
9. Refreshments should be provided to the teams with which the friendly matches are organized.
10. The venue TGT (P & HE) / deputed TGT (P & HE) of Kho Kho Boys U- 17 should look after the welfare of the students, in consultation with the venue Principals, including all arrangements like food, medicines, stay arrangements etc. The food supply to the students should be as per the specifications already circulated to all the KV's. The venue Principal of Kho Kho U-14 Boys will make necessary arrangement to look after the welfare of the students including all arrangements like food, medicines, and all other arrangements.
11. The Coaching Camp venue Principals will relieve the escort teachers along with the list of participants to the principal of the respective venue of 50th KVS National Sports Meet 2019.
12. Further they should settle the expenditure statement (Boys contingent) along with the list of medal winners , brief report of every game and photographs of the events with captions to the Principal of coaching camp venue after handing over the participants to the escort teachers of respective Vidyalaya.
13. The advance has to be paid to the escorts through RTGS / cheque/ cash before the team departs for the KVS National Sports Meet.
14. The Escort Teachers for Kho Kho U-14, 17 Boys will collect the advance for the participants from the Principal of coaching camp venue.
15. The escort teachers collect the advance for self from the Principal of the KV from where the escort teacher belongs to.
- 16. All the Principals will send DA (by cheque or cash) of their school students for coaching camp as well as for the journey of KVS National Sports Meet along with the escort teachers who will be handing over the students to the escorts of KVS National Sports Meet 2019.**
- 17. All the Principals will send DA (by cash) of their school students for the Journey of KVS National Sports Meet along with the escort teachers who Will be handing over the students to the escorts of KVS National Sports Meet 2019 (Taekwondo, Judo & Rope Skipping Boys U-14, 17, 19).**

THIS IS THE FINAL LIST OF ESCORT TEACHERS. NO REQUEST WILL BE ENTERTAINED FOR EXEMPTION FROM ESCORTING DUTY

All the Escort teachers must carry along with them **Medical Kit worth (Maximum of Rs 500/-)** and other essential items which may be required for any emergency.

The students should be duly escorted by the regular teacher of the respective Vidyalaya for dropping & taking them back after the meet.

The journey details to be informed to the parents and participants by the Principal of the respective vidyalayas.

All escorts should be vigilant during journey, during boarding and getting out of the train/ bus.

Students should not be allowed to get out of the train at every stop. All precautions should be taken while crossing the road, during commuting from stay venue to play venue etc.

Students should be instructed not to carry/ bring with them costly electronic gadgets, jewellery, heavy cash. Students should be instructed to be vigilant about their personal belongings like luggage, cash etc during the journey.

All the Escort teachers of KVS National Meet 2019 will report to the venue as mentioned above.

All the Principals are requested to depute Escort teachers to collect back the students after the national meet, from Principal KV MG Railway as per the train schedule given below.

A copy of the instruction to the students should be handed over to all the students & parents and a copy signed by the parents should be kept for records in the school

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE STUDENTS/PARENTS

Principals are requested to hand over the following instruction to the students and parents and collect back the no objection duly signed by the parents and students.

1. Students are not allowed to Alight / Board from the train/ bus/or any vehicle at the time of start or before stopping or while in motion..
2. No student should be near the door or any exit points of train/bus when the train/vehicle is moving.
3. The students should watch the gap between the train and platform and they should Alight or board carefully.
4. Students are not allowed to take any junk food sold by the hawkers on the platform or in the train and avoid consumption of aerated drinks like Pepsi/ CoCo Cola/ Fanta etc.
5. Students are not allowed to carry any valuable items like I Pad, cameras, Mobile Phones, jewellery, heavy cash etc. KVS will not be responsible for any loss/theft of any valuables and personal belongings.
6. Do not carry heavy luggage. Students should come with light essential items like toothpaste, toothbrush, soap (toilet items), essential medical items which are taken regularly should be carried by the individual.
7. At the stay venue, students should not damage any fittings like tube light, tap, shower, windowpanes, mirrors, fan regulators, switches, buckets, mugs, charts, display items which are displayed in the school or any other fittings or display items in the school premises. Do not put sanitary items/soap papers in WC and wash basin which may block the drainage system.
8. Students should not share their friend's soap, towel, toothbrush, and dresses for good hygiene.
9. Students should not create nuisance in the train/bus or in the platform which might cause inconvenience for the co passengers.
10. Students should not tease/bully the juniors, teammates, roommates, during the travel and stay. Any complaint received at the later stage either from the students/teachers/venue KV/ Escorts, disciplinary action will be initiated against the students.
